

**ELK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES
ORDINANCE NO. 2007-05
VACATING OF TOWNSHIP ROAD T-354
August 6, 2007**

The Elk Township Board of Supervisors Public Hearing convened at 6:30 PM at the Elk Township Building, Lewisville, PA. The following Supervisors were present: Chairman Palmer Durborow; Vice Chairman Estace Walters; and member Albert Jezyk, Jr. Also in attendance was Township Solicitor R. Samuel McMichael.

Township Solicitor Sam McMichael explained that the Springlawn Road Temporary Access Agreement requires that upon completion of the trail, the road be vacated and the Permanent Easement Agreement be recorded. Due to time constraints of the grant, the ordinance to vacate the road is taking place prior to completion of the trail. However, the vacating is conditioned upon the recording of the Permanent Easement Agreement within six months of the date of the ordinance.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Township resident Jeff Knowland asked if this vacates the road to make the trail. Sam replied yes and stated that the Township has exclusive rights to regulate the trail and will comply to the best of its ability with the terms.

There were no additional comments or objections to the ordinances.
